

# Maintenance instructions

## Chameleon PET felt

*Not applicable to printed PET felt.*



### Cleaning

#### Removing Dust and Dirt

Is there visible dust or dirt embedded in the material? Gently loosen it using a soft-bristled brush, taking care not to apply too much pressure. Carefully remove the loosened particles with a vacuum cleaner.

#### Cleaning Light Stains

First, remove any loose dust and dirt (see above). Blot spilled liquids as quickly as possible to prevent them from penetrating the material. Then, apply a mild cleaning solution or soapy water using a hand spray bottle. Avoid saturating the surface. Allow the material to air dry.

#### Cleaning stubborn stains

Dampen a lint-free cloth with a mild cleaning solution or a mixture of soap and water. Gently blot the stain from the outside inwards, without rubbing. If necessary, use a clean cloth and repeat the process until no more dirt is visible on the cloth. Then remove any remaining cleaning solution with a dry cloth. Use a clean, damp cloth or sponge to wipe away any residues. Allow the surface to air dry.

Is the stain still visible after these steps? Try using a cleaner suitable for upholstery or carpet fabrics and follow the instructions on the label carefully.

### Repair

#### Removing creases

Creases in PET felt can be smoothed out using an iron. Set the iron to its highest temperature setting. Place a sheet of baking paper over the felt to prevent fibers from sticking to the iron. Slowly and evenly glide the iron over the surface until the creases are gone.
